Are you ready for the Nov. 8 General Election?

AUBURN, Calif. -- Placer County is proud to have active and informed citizens who exercise their right to participate in elections. But in order to vote, you must be registered!

Not sure if your voter registration is up-to-date? A few minutes online can tell you all you need to know. Visit voterstatus.sos.ca.gov to confirm your voter status, political party preference, address and any other information related to your voter registration.

Discovered that you're not currently registered or your registration information needs updating? Not to worry! Just visit registertovote.ca.gov to register online. Registration forms may also be picked up at the Elections Office at 2956 Richardson Drive in North Auburn, or from any Department of Motor Vehicles, post office or library in Placer County. The deadline to register to vote and receive your voter materials by mail for the Nov. 8 General Election is **Monday, Oct. 24**.

For residents who miss the 15-day registration deadline, conditional voter registration is available. Eligible voters can come to the Elections Office 14 days before the election (starting Oct. 25) through Election Day (Nov. 8) to conditionally register to vote. Conditionally registered voters are required to register and vote a ballot during the same visit. Voters may also visit a polling location on Election Day to conditionally register to vote and cast a ballot.

Want your vote to be counted in the first results shared on election night? Vote early! Complete your ballot and return it to us by mail or at a drop box (click this [link](#) for a list of locations).
