QUICK REFERENCE CALENDAR FOR MARCH 3, 2020 PRESIDENTIAL PRIMARY ELECTION Candidate Calendar - Draft	
September 12, 2019 (E-173)	Signature-in-lieu collection period begins for all candidates.
October 28, 2019 (E-127)	First day candidates for judicial offices may file the Declaration of Intention.
November 6, 2019 (E-118)	Last day for judicial candidates to file the Declaration of Intention. This period is extended if the incumbent does not file.
November 6, 2019 (E-118)	Signature-in-lieu collection period closes for all candidates.
* November 11, 2019 (E-113)	Close of extended filing period for the Declaration of Intention.
* November 11, 2019 (E-113)	Candidate filing begins.
* November 11, 2019 (E-113)	Last day for statewide candidates to submit a candidate statement to the Secretary of State for inclusion in the State Voter Guide.
December 6, 2019 (E-88)	Close of regular candidate-filing period. Extended candidate-filing period begins for some offices.
December 11, 2019 (E-83)	Close of extended candidate-filing period.
December 12, 2019 (E-82)	Random alphabet draw to be held at 11 AM to determine the ballot order of candidates' names.
January 6, 2020 (E-57)	Write-in candidate-filing period begins.
January 23, 2020 (E-40)	County Voter Information Guide may begin to be mailed.
January 31, 2020 (E-32)	Last day to file semi-annual campaign statements (from last statement to 12/31/19).
February 3, 2020 (E-29)	First day to process vote-by-mail ballot requests.
February 18, 2020 (E-14)	First day for conditional registration for this election.
February 18, 2020 (E-14)	Write-in candidate filing period ends.
February 25, 2020 (E-7)	Last day to request vote-by-mail ballot by mail.
March 3, 2020	ELECTION DAY
