January 16, 2019 (E-69)	Signature in lieu collection period begins for this election.
January 16, 2019 (E-69)	Candidate filing begins for this election.
January 22, 2019 (E-63)	Last day for candidates to submit signature in lieu of filing fee.
January 28, 2019 (E-57)	Write-in candidate filing period begins for this election.
January 31, 2019 (E-54)	Close of candidate filing period.
February 1, 2019 (E-53)	Random alphabet draw to be held to determine the ballot order of candidates' names.
February 9, 2019 * (E-45)	Ballots sent to military and overseas voters by this date.
February 14, 2019 (E-40)	First day county voter information guides can be mailed. (Deadline to mail to voters is 3/5/2019)
February 25, 2019 (E-29)	First day vote by mail ballots can be mailed.
March 11, 2019 (E-15)	Last day to register for this election.
March 12, 2019 (E-14)	First day of Conditional Voter Registration for this election.
March 12, 2019 (E-14)	Write-in candidate filing period ends for this election.
March 19, 2019 (E-7)	Last day to request vote by mail ballot by mail.
March 26, 2019	ELECTION DAY
April 2, 2019 (E+7)	Last day for a voter whose signature did not match to complete and return an "unsigned verification statement".
April 3, 2019 (E+8)	Last day for a voter who did not sign the vote by mail ballot envelope to return an "unsigned verification statement".
April 4, 2019 (E+9)	Last day to complete the canvassing and certify the election.

\*Elections Code section 3114 requires that ballots and ballot materials be transmitted to each military and overseas voter on the 45<sup>th</sup> day before the election. E-45 is February 9, 2019, which is Saturday, this deadline does not move forward to the next business day.
