I was raised in the Loomis area while attending St. Albans Elementary and Jesuit High School. I earned a B.A. in Economics and Political Science from U.C. Santa Barbara, and my law degree from George Washington University, Washington, D.C.

I successfully prosecuted Placer County's first no-body homicide involving a woman who disappeared after leaving a casino. Currently I supervise three units in the District Attorney's Office and contribute to the justice system through teaching, writing, and speaking. I created the Citizens Recognition Program honoring community members for their courage assisting law enforcement and victims.
