

Candidate Workshop



The Placer County Elections Division will conduct a **free** Candidate Workshop on February 13, 2008 for prospective candidates. The workshop will be held at the Elections Division, located at 2956 Richardson Drive, in the DeWitt Center in Auburn. It will begin at 6:30 PM and end at approximately 9:30 PM.

The workshop will cover the following topics:

- Filing times, dates, and deadlines for candidates running in the June 3, 2008 Statewide Direct Primary Election
- Forms required to file for Public Office
- Offices up for Election
- Effective campaigning techniques
- Election Data products
- Media involvement

Prospective candidates and their supporters, members of the media and the general public are all invited to attend this **free** seminar. The workshop will explain many of the details involved in running for public office.

A panel of guest speakers will share their knowledge and experience in a wide range of topics. Speakers will include Jim McCauley, the County Clerk-Recorder-Registrar of Voters, along with election staff, successful candidates, and the media. There will be a question and answer period after each speaker.

The candidate-filing period for the June 3, 2008 Statewide Direct Primary Election opens February 11, 2008 and closes March 7, 2008. Filing is approaching fast. Get involved in your community—become a candidate!
