The petition in lieu of filing fee period to fill the vacancy in the State Assembly 4<sup>th</sup> District began January 5, 2011. The petition-in-lieu may be used by candidates to reduce or eliminate the filing fee for the Assembly 4<sup>th</sup> District race. This paperwork is available from the Placer County Office of Elections. The last day to circulate and file the petition-in-lieu is January 13, 2011. By collecting voters' signatures on the petition, the candidate may cover all or any prorated portion of the filing fee.

Candidate filing opens January 11, 2011 and closes on January 24, 2011. During this time, candidates may pick up the nomination documents needed to get their names on the Special Election ballot at the Placer County Office of Elections.

Candidates can pick up the petition-in-lieu and nomination documents at the Placer County Office of Elections, located at 2956 Richardson Drive, Auburn. Hours of operation are 8:00 AM to 5:00 PM, Monday through Friday excluding holidays.
