NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN by Jim McCauley, Placer County Clerk-Recorder-Registrar of Voters, in accordance with the provisions of the Election Laws of the State of California, on Tuesday, May 3, 2011 there will be a Special General Election to be held in State Assembly District 4.

NOTICE IS GIVEN that the last day to register to vote for the Special General Election is April 18, 2011.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that vote-by-mail ballots will begin to mail on April 4, 2011. The last day for the Office of Elections to mail a requested vote-by-mail ballot is April 26, 2011.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that at the Special General Election the polls will be open from the hour of 7:00 AM to the hour of 8:00 PM on the day thereof.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that after the polls are closed on the date of said election, the ballots will be transported to the central counting location at the Placer County Office of Elections, 2956 Richardson Drive, Auburn, CA 95603.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that the opening and processing of the vote-by-mail ballots for said election will take place at the Placer County Office of Elections starting April 22, 2011 and continue through Election Night, May 3, 2011.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that the canvass will commence on or before 8:00 AM on May 5, 2011 at the Placer County Office of Elections.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that the Office of Elections will be open for business the weekend prior to the Special General Election (April 30<sup>th</sup> and May 1<sup>st</sup>) from 9:00 AM to 4:00 PM.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN, in accordance with provisions of the election laws of the State of California, that on April 25, 2011 at 10:00 AM, the Placer County Office of Elections will randomly select precincts for a manual tally of one percent (1%) of the precincts casting ballots at the May 3, 2011 Special General Election.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that this random selection of precincts is open to the public.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that on May 5, 2011 at 9:00 AM, the Placer County Office of Elections will begin a manual tally of one percent (1%) of the precincts casting ballots at the May 3, 2011 Special General Election.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that this manual tally is open to the public and shall continue daily (Saturdays, Sundays and holidays excluded unless otherwise decided by the County Registrar of Voters) until completed.
