February 1, 2012 (E-125)	Last day resolution and boundary maps can be presented to the Office of Elections to guarantee placement of measure on ballot.
February 10, 2012 (E-116)	Resolution to County Counsel and CEO for agenda review (15 days before BOS meeting).
February 13, 2012 (E-113)	Candidate filing begins. The Office of Elections is open from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. on the Lincoln's Birthday Holiday.
February 28, 2012 (E-98)	Resolution on BOS agenda for approval.
March 9, 2012 (E-88)	Close of regular candidate-filing period. Extended candidate-filing period begins for some offices.
March 9, 2012 (E-88)	Impartial analysis due. Tax rate statement due if applicable to measure.
March 9, 2012 (E-88)	Last day to file arguments for and against Measures A through F.
March 13, 2012 (E-84)	Last day to file arguments for and against Measure G.
March 14, 2012 (E-83)	Close of extended candidate-filing period.
March 19, 2012 (E-78)	Last day to file rebuttal arguments for and against all measures.
April 26, 2012 (E-40)	First day sample ballots may be mailed to voters.
May 7, 2012 (E-29)	First day to process vote-by-mail ballot requests.
May 21, 2012 (E-15)	Last day to register for this election.
May 24 – June 3, 2012 (E-12 to E-2)	Precinct officer training classes to be conducted during this period.
May 29, 2012 (E-7)	Last day to request vote-by-mail ballot by mail.
