December 14, 2017 (E-158)	Signature-in-lieu collection period begins for all candidates.
January 29, 2018 (E-127)	First day candidates for judicial offices may file the Declaration of Intention.
January 31, 2018 (E-126)	Last day to file semi-annual campaign statements (from last statement to 12/31/17).
February 7, 2018 (E-118)	Last day for judicial candidates to file the Declaration of Intention. This period is extended if the incumbent does not file.
February 7, 2018 (E-118)	Signature-in-lieu collection period closes for all candidates.
* February 12, 2018 (E-112)	Close of extended filing period for the Declaration of Intention.
* February 12, 2018 (E-112)	Candidate filing begins.
February 14, 2018 (E-111)	Last day for statewide candidates to submit a candidate statement to the Secretary of State for inclusion in the State Voter Guide
March 9, 2018 (E-88)	Close of regular candidate-filing period. Extended candidate-filing period begins for some offices.
March 14, 2018 (E-83)	Close of extended candidate-filing period.
March 15, 2018 (E-82)	Random alphabet draw to be held at 11 AM to determine the ballot order of candidates' names.
April 9, 2018 (E-57)	Write-in candidate-filing period begins
April 26, 2018 (E-40)	Sample ballots may begin to be mailed.
May 7, 2018 (E-29)	First day to process vote-by-mail ballot requests.
May 22, 2018 (E-14)	First day for conditional registration for this election.
May 22, 2018 (E-14)	Write-in candidate filing period ends.
May 29, 2018 (E-7)	Last day to request vote-by-mail ballot by mail.
June 5, 2018	ELECTION DAY
