Candidates for judicial offices are required to file a Declaration of Intention prior to the candidate filing period. The first day the Declaration of Intention may be issued is February 1, 2010. The last day to file the Declaration of Intention is February 10, 2010. If an incumbent fails to file, the deadline for that office extends until February 16, 2010 for individuals other than the incumbent. Judicial candidates must file the Declaration of Intention prior to filing for office in order to appear on the ballot.

Candidate filing begins February 16, 2010 and continues through March 12, 2010. If an incumbent fails to file during this time period, candidate filing will extend 5 days for any candidate except the incumbent and end on March 17, 2010. When the incumbent files there will not be an extension of candidate filing for that office.

Judicial candidates can pick up the Declaration of Intention at the Placer County Elections Division, located at 2956 Richardson Drive, Auburn.
