

NOTICE BY THE PLACER COUNTY REGISTRAR OF VOTERS OF MEASURES TO BE VOTED ON AT THE GUBERNATORIAL GENERAL ELECTION.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN by Jim McCauley, Placer County Clerk-Recorder-Registrar of Voters, in accordance with the provisions of the Election Laws of the State of California, on Tuesday, November 2, 2010 there will be a Gubernatorial General Election.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that consolidated with the Gubernatorial General Election the following measures shall be put to a vote of the qualified voters in the City of Roseville:

Measure B – City of Roseville

Shall the City Charter be amended: (1) Out-of-date provisions: sections 1.055, 2.06, 2.07, 2.10, 2.12, 2.13, 3.02, 3.03, 4.02, 4.05, 5.03; (2) Up-dated provisions: sections: 2.14, 3.09, 8.02, 8.03, 8.04, 8.05, 8.07, 9.01; (3) Typographical corrections: sections 4.06, 6.01; (4) Minor procedural changes: sections 1.05, 2.04, 2.09; (5) Capitalizing the word City, replacing the word member with councilmember, and adding the word City to all named officials?

Measure C – City of Roseville

Shall the City Charter be amended as follows: (1) Section 2.02, providing that a partial City Council term served due to appointment to a vacant council seat does not count as a term for the purposes of this section; and (2) Section 2.05, changing title of mayor pro tempore to vice mayor?

Measure D – City of Roseville

Shall the City Charter be amended as follows: (1) Section 2.03, modifying the time frame for assumption of office by, and seating of, elected councilmembers, to conform to California Elections Code §15372?

Measure E – City of Roseville

Shall the City Charter be amended with respect to minor fiscal matters as follows: (1) Section 7.09 and 7.10, updating Charter to conform to changes in state tax and assessment law beginning with the passage of Proposition 13 in 1978; (2) Section 7.095 deleting and reserving section; (3) Minor procedural and typographical amendments: sections 7.05, 7.06, 7.15, 7.19 and 7.20?

Measure F – City of Roseville

Shall the City Charter be amended with regard to certain fiscal matters as follows: (1) Section 7.21, allowing adoption of an ordinance establishing bidding preference for businesses located within the City of Roseville?

Measure G – City of Roseville

Shall the City Charter be amended with regard to certain fiscal matters as follows: (1) Section 7.21, increasing dollar amount of items requiring a sealed bid from \$10,000 to \$19,500?

Measure H – City of Roseville

Shall the City Charter be amended as follows: (1) Section 2.02, providing that term limits be modified from two (2) consecutive four (4) year terms to three (3) terms of four (4) years each, such that a person would be ineligible to hold office after serving on the Council for

three (3) four (4) year terms?

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that direct arguments for or against said measure(s) shall be submitted to the Roseville City Clerk. Said arguments shall not exceed 300 words in length and may be received or withdrawn, but not changed, prior to and including August 6, 2010 at 5:00 PM. The elections official shall cause (if submitted) one argument for and/or one argument against said measure(s) to be printed and shall cause to be enclosed a copy thereof in each sample ballot. If multiple arguments are submitted either for or against a measure, the elections official shall choose and print one argument in accordance with applicable law or procedure.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that, for individuals interested in submitting arguments for or against said measure(s), the physical address for the Roseville City Clerk is 311 Vernon Street, Roseville CA 95678. The mailing address for the Roseville City Clerk is the same as above.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that when the elections official has selected the direct arguments for and against said measure(s), the Roseville City Clerk shall send copies of the argument in favor of said measure(s) to the authors of the argument against and copies of the argument against to the authors of the argument in favor. The authors may prepare and submit rebuttal arguments not to exceed 250 words. The rebuttal arguments must be filed with the Roseville City Clerk not later than 10 days after the final date for filing direct arguments. The final date for rebuttal arguments is August 16, 2010 at 5:00 PM.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that California Elections Code Section 9600 governs the form of said arguments and/or rebuttals. Arguments and/or rebuttals submitted to the Roseville City Clerk must follow this form.
