

## NOTICE OF ELECTION

NOTICE BY THE PLACER COUNTY REGISTRAR OF VOTERS OF OFFICES FOR WHICH CANDIDATES ARE TO BE NOMINATED OR ELECTED AT THE STATEWIDE GENERAL ELECTION. NOTICE OF CENTRAL COUNTING LOCATION. NOTICE OF WEEKEND OFFICE HOURS. NOTICE OF LAST DAY TO REGISTER. NOTICE OF VOTE-BY-MAIL BALLOTS ISSUED. NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that consolidated with the Statewide General Election the following measure shall be put to a vote of the qualified voters in the Western Placer Unified School District:

### Measure A – Western Placer Unified School District

To protect quality education, shall Western Placer Unified School District construct a new high school, and improve Lincoln High School by updating/replacing aging classrooms and support facilities, and instructional technology needed for improved teaching, replacing portable classrooms, repairing/replacing roofs, worn-out floors, electrical systems, seismic upgrades and improving energy efficiency to save money and support instruction by issuing \$60,000,000 in bonds at legal rates, with independent oversight, no money for administrators and all money staying local?

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that consolidated with the Statewide General Election the following measure shall be put to a vote of the qualified voters in the County of Placer

### Measure B – Placer County Charter Amendment

In order to provide an effective representative government, restrict future pay increases, pension and healthcare costs, shall Placer County amend Article II, Section 207 of the County Charter to limit the Board of Supervisors salary to no more than the average salary of County Supervisors in the neighboring Counties of El Dorado, Nevada, and Sacramento, with any change in this methodology subject to a vote of the citizens of Placer County?

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that consolidated with the Statewide General Election the following measures shall be put to a vote of the qualified voters in the Tahoe Truckee Unified School District

### Measure E – Tahoe Truckee Unified School District

To improve Tahoe area schools with local funding that the State cannot take away, repair/replace roofs, plumbing and electrical systems, provide classrooms, science labs and technology meeting modern academic safety standards and providing a well-rounded education, construct, equip, repair, acquire school facilities/equipment to prepare students for college/high-demand jobs, shall School Facilities Improvement District No. 2 of the Tahoe-Truckee Unified School District issue \$62,000,000 in bonds at legal rates with independent audits, citizen oversight, and no funds for administrators' salaries?

### Measure U – Tahoe Truckee Unified School District

To improve Truckee area schools with funding that the State cannot take away, repair/replace roofs, plumbing and electrical systems, help local schools qualify for State matching funds, and construct, equip, repair/acquire classrooms, science labs, career technical education facilities to provide a well-rounded education and prepare students for college/high-demand jobs, shall School Facilities Improvement District No. 1 of the Tahoe-Truckee Unified School District issue \$114,000,000 in bonds at legal rates with independent audits, citizen oversight, and no funds for administrators' salaries?

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, to the qualified electors of the East Nicolaus Joint Union High School District, in the County of Sutter, and in the County of Placer, State of California, that in accordance with the provisions of the California Education Code, a general election will be held on Tuesday, November 4, 2014, in said District, at which the following measure shall be submitted to the qualified electors of the District and voted upon.

### Measure W – East Nicolaus Joint Union High School District Bond Measure

To improve the quality of education with funding that cannot be taken by the State; repair or replace leaky roofs; modernize outdated classrooms, restrooms and school facilities; replace outdated heating, ventilation and air-conditioning systems; make health and safety improvements; and replace temporary portables with permanent classrooms; shall the East Nicolaus High School District issue \$4,000,000 of bonds at legal interest rates, have an independent citizens' oversight committee and have NO money used for administrative salaries?

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that direct arguments for or against said measure(s) shall be submitted to the Placer County Office of Elections (except arguments for municipal measures). Said arguments shall not exceed 300 words in length and may be received or withdrawn, but not changed, prior to and including August 8, 2014 at 5:00 PM. The Placer County Registrar of Voters shall cause (if submitted) one argument for and/or one argument against said measure(s) to be printed and shall cause to be enclosed a copy thereof in each sample ballot. If multiple arguments are submitted either for or against a measure, the Placer County Registrar of Voters shall choose and print one argument in accordance with applicable law or procedure.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that, for individuals interested in submitting arguments for or against said measure(s), the physical address for the Placer County Office of Elections is 2956 Richardson Drive, Auburn. The mailing address for the Placer County Office of Elections is PO Box 5278, Auburn, CA 95604.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that when the Placer County Registrar of Voters has selected the direct arguments for and against said measure(s), the Placer County Registrar of Voters shall send copies of the argument in favor of said measure(s) to the authors of the argument against and copies of the argument against to the authors of the argument in favor. The authors may prepare and submit rebuttal arguments not to exceed 250 words. The rebuttal arguments must be filed with the Placer County Registrar of Voters not later than 10 days after the final date for filing direct arguments. The final date for rebuttal arguments is August 18, 2014 at 5:00 PM.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that California Elections Code Section 9600 governs the form of said arguments and/or rebuttals. Arguments and/or rebuttals submitted to the Placer County Office of Elections must follow this form. NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that the last day to register to vote for the Statewide General Election is October 20, 2014.
