QUICK REFERENCE CALENDAR FOR THE NOVEMBER 6, 2012 GENERAL ELECTION Measure Calendar - Draft	
July 5, 2012 ¹ (E-124)	Last day resolution and boundary maps can be presented to the Office of Elections to guarantee placement of measure on ballot.
July 23, 2012 (E-106)	Resolution to County Counsel and CEO for agenda review (15 days before BOS meeting).
July 31, 2012 (E-98)	Last day to file semi-annual campaign statements (from last statement to 6/30/12).
August 7, 2012 (E-91)	Resolution on BOS agenda for approval (assumes BOS meeting on this date).
August 10, 2012 (E-88)	Impartial analysis due. Tax rate statement due if applicable to measure.
August 10, 2012 (E-88)	Last day to file arguments for and against measures.
August 20, 2012 (E-78)	Last day to file rebuttal arguments for and against measures.
September 27, 2012 (E-40)	First day sample ballots may be mailed to voters.
October 5, 2012 (E-32)	Last day to file 1 st pre-election campaign statements (from last statement to 9/30/12).
October 8, 2012 ² (E-29)	First day to issue vote-by-mail ballots.
October 12 – November 4, 2012 (E-25 to E-2)	Precinct officer training classes to be conducted during this period.
October 21 – November 5, 2012 (E-16 to E-1)	Contributions and independent expenditures of \$1,000 or more need to be reported within 24 hours. Form 410 needs to be filed within 24 hours if a committee qualifies or has a change.
October 22, 2012 (E-15)	Last day to register for this election.
October 25, 2012 (E-12)	Last day to file 2 nd pre-election campaign statements (from last statement to 10/20/12).
October 30, 2012 (E-7)	Last day to request vote-by-mail ballot by mail.
November 6, 2012	ELECTION DAY
