The last day to register to vote and receive a ballot and Voter Information Guide by mail for the November 2, 2021, Community Service District Special Election for the Northstar Community Services District is October 18, 2021. Registration forms may be picked up at our Elections Office, any Department of Motor Vehicles, post office, and library in Placer County or accessed online at www.registertovote.ca.gov. To further assist Placer County voters, voter registration forms will be placed outside the Placer County Elections Office entrance at 2956 Richardson Drive in Auburn, on October 18, 2021 until 12:00 AM (midnight). Completed registration forms will be processed the next morning. In addition, completed registration forms can be placed in the secure, drive-up drop-off box located in front of the Elections Office.

For voters who have missed the registration deadline we now have Conditional Voter Registration (CVR) in California. Under this law, eligible voters who missed the 15-day registration deadline can come to the Elections Office before Election Day and the day of the election or to their polling place on Election Day, conditionally register to vote, and vote a ballot.

The Elections Office is located at 2956 Richardson Drive in Auburn. Office hours are Monday through Friday, 8:00 AM to 5:00 PM. Election Day hours are 7:00 AM to 8:00 PM. Voters may call 530-886-5650 or toll-free in California, 1-800-824-8683, with questions regarding the upcoming election. Elections staff will be available to process vote by mail requests and issue ballots over the counter.

If you have interacted recently with the DMV, your voter registration information may have been changed. It is important to confirm your voter status; political party

preference, address, and all other pertinent information to make sure you are still registered correctly. Check your status at voterstatus.sos.ca.gov.
