NOTICE BY THE PLACER COUNTY REGISTRAR OF VOTERS OF AN ALL MAIL BALLOT SPECIAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION IN THE CITY OF ROCKLIN. NOTICE OF CENTRAL COUNTING LOCATION. NOTICE OF WEEKEND OFFICE HOURS. NOTICE OF LAST DAY TO REGISTER. NOTICE OF MAIL BALLOTS ISSUED. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN by Jim McCauley, Placer County Clerk-Recorder-Registrar of Voters, in accordance with the provisions of the Election Laws of the State of California that an All Mail Ballot Special Municipal Election is to be held in the City of Rocklin on Tuesday, August 25, 2009.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that the following measure shall be put to a vote of the qualified voters in the City of Rocklin:

Measure A

To keep park and recreation facilities safe, clean and well maintained, shall Rocklin City Ordinance No. 949, reenacting the Park Maintenance and Development Act of 1998, be approved which would allow the City to continue to collect a \$10.00 to \$30.00 per year special tax to be used only for park maintenance and development?

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that the last day to register to vote for the All Mail Ballot Special Municipal Election is August 10, 2009.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that mail ballots will begin to mail on July 27, 2009. The last day for the Elections Division to mail a replacement ballot is August 14, 2009.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that the All Mail Ballot Special Municipal Election will be conducted by mail ballot only. Placer County Elections staff will be available to accept voted ballots and issue replacement ballots at the Placer County Elections Division, 2956 Richardson Drive, Auburn, from July 27, 2009 through August 24, 2009 during regular office hours as posted and at the Rocklin Fire Station #2 located at 3401 Crest Drive in Rocklin from August 17, 2009 through August 24, 2009 from 8:00 AM to 5:00 PM, Monday through Friday. Staff will also be available to accept voted ballots and issue replacement ballots at the Placer County Elections Division and at the City of Rocklin Fire Station #2 on Election Day, August 25, 2009 from 7:00 AM to 8:00 PM.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that Elections staff will be available to accept voted ballots and issue replacement ballots at the Elections Division and the Rocklin Fire Station #2 the weekend prior to the All Mail Ballot Special Municipal Election (August 22nd and 23rd) from 9:00 AM to 4:00 PM.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that the opening and processing of the mail ballots for said election will take place at the central counting location at the Placer County Elections Division on or after August 14, 2009 and continue through Election Night, August 25, 2009.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that the canvass will commence on or before 8:00 AM on

August 27, 2009 at the Placer County Elections Division.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN, in accordance with provisions of the election laws of the State of California, that on August 26, 2009 at 10:00 AM, the Placer County Elections Division will randomly select precincts for a manual tally of one percent (1%) and any ten percent (10%) manual tally required of the precincts casting ballots at the August 25, 2009 All Mail Ballot Special Municipal Election.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that this random selection of precincts is open to the public.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that on August 27, 2009 at 8:30 AM, the Placer County Elections Division will begin a manual tally of one percent (1%) and any ten percent (10%) manual tally required of the precincts casting ballots at the August 25, 2009 All Mail Ballot Special Municipal Election.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that this manual tally is open to the public and shall continue daily (Saturdays, Sundays and holidays excluded unless otherwise decided by the County Registrar of Voters) until completed.
