



March 3, 2020 Presidential Primary Election

IMPORTANT DATES:

- **January 1, 2020** – Crossover ballot requests due on or before this date.
- **January 18, 2020** – Ballots for military and overseas (UOCAVA) voters issued
- **February 17, 2020** – Last day to register for this election
- **February 25, 2020** – Last day to request a vote-by-mail ballot to be sent by mail
- **March 3, 2020** – Election Day

NOTE: If after January 28th you have not received your ballot and would like to request a replacement or request an alternative delivery method, contact our Elections Office for assistance.

VOTING OPTIONS FOR NO PARTY PREFERENCE VOTERS FOR THE MARCH 3, 2020 PRESIDENTIAL PRIMARY ELECTION

If you are a No Party Preference voter, you have three options:

- Do nothing. You will receive a ballot that **does not** include candidates for president.
- To crossover and vote for an American Independent, Democratic or Libertarian Presidential candidate, complete the No Party Preference postcard that was mailed to you and return it by **January 1, 2020**.
- Additional Request Options: Call, email or fax the Elections Office with your requested crossover information by **January 1, 2020**.
- To vote for an American Independent, Democratic, or Libertarian central committee candidate, you must re-register to vote by **February 17, 2020** to receive your ballot by mail.

Your signed request can be emailed to vote@placer.ca.gov, faxed to (530) 886-5688, or mailed to the Elections Office.

You may not request more than one party's ballot and you may only vote once. If you have questions, please call the Election's Office at (530)886-5650, Monday through Friday, between 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m.
