Candidates for judicial offices are required to file a Declaration of Intention prior to the candidate-filing period. The first day the Declaration of Intention may be issued is January 30, 2012. The last day to file the Declaration of Intention is February 8, 2012. If an incumbent fails to file, the deadline for that office extends until February 13, 2012 for individuals other than the incumbent. Judicial candidates must file the Declaration of Intention prior to filing for office in order to appear on the ballot.

Candidate filing begins February 13, 2012 and continues through March 9, 2012. If an incumbent fails to file during this time period, candidate filing will extend 5 days for any candidate except the incumbent and end on March 14, 2012. When the incumbent files there will not be an extension of candidate filing for that office.

Judicial candidates can pick up the Declaration of Intention at the Placer County Office of Elections, located at 2956 Richardson Drive, Auburn. Hours of operation are 8:00 AM to 5:00 PM, Monday through Friday excluding holidays. The Office of Elections will also be open on the following holidays from 9:00 AM to 3:00 PM: February 13, 2012 (Lincoln's Birthday) and February 20, 2012 (President's Day).
