All Placer County registered voters should start checking their mailboxes for the June 5, 2018 Statewide Direct Primary Election Sample Ballot Pamphlet. Sample ballot pamphlets will begin to mail on April 26, 2018.

The sample ballot pamphlet will provide voters with important information about items to be voted on this election. In addition, your polling place location is listed on the back cover of your sample ballot pamphlet. If you are a permanent vote-by-mail voter or if you reside in a mail ballot precinct, your pamphlet will read **Permanent Vote-by-Mail Voter or Mail Ballot Precinct** in the polling place location area of the pamphlet.

For voters who are not permanent vote-by-mail voters and voters who do not reside in a mail ballot precinct, the back cover of the sample ballot pamphlet can be used as a vote-by-mail ballot application. Simply sign the form return it to the Placer County Elections Office or call to request a ballot to be mailed to you: 530-886-5650 or toll-free in California 1-800-824-8683. Remember, if you are a **Permanent Vote-by-Mail Voter**, a request for a vote-by-mail ballot is **not** necessary. You will automatically receive your ballot in the mail.

Vote-by-mail ballots will begin mailing on May 7, 2018. You can either use the vote-by-mail ballot request form on your sample ballot pamphlet, download a request form from our website at www.placerelections.com, call our office to request a ballot to be mailed to you: 530-886-5650 or toll-free in California 1-800-824-8683, or email us your application to election@placer.ca.gov. To ensure sufficient processing time, the last day by law that the Elections Office can mail a voter-requested vote-by-mail ballot is May 29, 2018. You may pick up a vote-by-mail ballot in our office from May 7, 2018 until Election Day, June 5, 2018. The Elections Office is located at 2956 Richardson Drive in

Auburn. Office hours are Monday through Friday, 8:00 AM to 5:00 PM. Election Day hours are 7:00 AM to 8:00 PM.

If you do not receive your sample ballot pamphlet by May 16, 2018 or if you misplace your sample ballot pamphlet, please contact the Elections Office at 530-886-5650 or toll free in California 1-800-824-8683 for a duplicate sample ballot pamphlet.
