NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that official nomination petitions and declarations of candidacy for eligible Placer County residents desiring to file for an elective office may be obtained from the Placer County Elections Division, 2956 Richardson Drive, Auburn, CA 95603. Completed Placer County nomination petitions and declarations of candidacy shall be returned to the Elections Division for filing.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that filing is open and will close Friday, March 12, 2010, after which time no declarations of candidacy may be accepted for filing. If an incumbent does not file his or her declaration of candidacy on or before March 12, 2010, the period for all nonincumbents to obtain and return declarations of candidacy will be extended to March 17, 2010.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that the hours for filing nomination petitions and declarations of candidacy during the filing period (and extended filing period, if necessary) will be Monday through Friday, 8:00 AM to 5:00 PM excluding holidays.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that the last day to register to vote for the Statewide Direct Primary Election is May 24, 2010.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that vote-by-mail ballots will begin to mail on May 10, 2010. The last day for the Elections Division to mail a requested vote-by-mail ballot is June 1, 2010.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that at the Statewide Direct Primary Election the polls will be open from the hour of 7:00 AM to the hour of 8:00 PM on the day thereof.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that after the polls are closed on the date of said election, the ballots will be transported to the central counting location at the Placer County Elections Division, 2956 Richardson Drive, Auburn, CA 95603.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that the opening and processing of the vote-by-mail ballots for said election will take place at the Placer County Elections Division starting May 28, 2010 and continue through Election Night, June 8, 2010.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that the canvass will commence on or before 8:00 AM on June 10, 2010 at the Placer County Elections Division.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that the Elections Division will be open for business the two weekends prior to the Statewide Direct Primary Election (May 29<sup>th</sup> and 30<sup>th</sup> and June 5<sup>th</sup> and June 6<sup>th</sup>) from 9:00 AM to 4:00 PM.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN, in accordance with provisions of the election laws of the State of California, that on June 9, 2010 at 10:00 AM, the Placer County Elections Division will randomly select precincts for a manual tally of one percent (1%) and any ten percent (10%) manual tally required of the precincts casting ballots at the June 8, 2010 Statewide Direct Primary Election.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that this random selection of precincts is open to the public.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that on June 21, 2010 at 9:00 AM, the Placer County Elections Division will begin a manual tally of one percent (1%) and any ten percent (10%) manual tally required of the precincts casting ballots at the June 8, 2010 Statewide Direct Primary Election.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that this manual tally is open to the public and shall continue daily (Saturdays, Sundays and holidays excluded unless otherwise decided by the County Registrar of Voters) until completed.
