February 3, 2010 (E-125)	Last day resolution and boundary maps can be presented to Elections Division to guarantee placement of measure on ballot.
February 8, 2010 (E-120)	Resolution to County Counsel and CEO for agenda review (15 days before BOS meeting).
February 16, 2010* (E-112)	Candidate filing begins.
February 23, 2010 (E-105)	Resolution on BOS agenda for approval.
March 12, 2010 (E-88)	Close of regular candidate filing period. Extended candidate filing period begins for some offices.
March 12, 2010 (E-88)	Impartial analysis due. Tax rate statement due if applicable to measure.
March 12, 2010 (E-88)	Last day to file arguments for and against measures.
March 17, 2010 (E-83)	Close of extended candidate filing period.
March 22, 2010 (E-78)	Last day to file rebuttal arguments for and against measures.
April 29, 2010 (E-40)	First day sample ballots may be mailed to voters.
May 10, 2010 (E-29)	First day to process vote by mail ballot requests.
May 27 – June 6, 2010 (E-12 to E-2)	Precinct officer training classes to be conducted during this period.
May 24, 2010 (E-15)	Last day to register for this election.
June 1, 2010 (E-7)	Last day to request vote by mail ballot by mail.
June 8, 2010	ELECTION DAY
