Candidate filing for the Statewide Direct General Election to be held November 4, 2014 begins on July 14, 2014. Every general election, dozens of people are appointed to local district boards because there are not enough people who file for office. There are still several local offices that will not appear on the November ballot if additional individuals do not file.

You have until August 8, 2014 (or August 13, 2014 if an incumbent does not file) to file for local office and make a difference in your community. If you would like to have a say in what happens to your community, filing for office is the perfect opportunity to do so. Give voters a choice in who will be making the decisions that affect them, instead of the board appointing someone for you.

Placer County residents in the Tahoe area will also be able to file at the Tahoe Customs House located at 775 North Lake Blvd, Tahoe City. Candidates can file for office there Monday through Friday, from 11:00 AM through 3:30 PM. Candidate filing in Tahoe will begin on July 16, 2014 instead of July 14.
