NOTICE BY THE PLACER COUNTY REGISTRAR OF VOTERS OF OFFICES FOR WHICH CANDIDATES ARE TO BE NOMINATED OR ELECTED AT THE SPECIAL GENERAL ELECTION. NOTICE OF BALLOT MEASURE TO BE DECIDED. NOTICE OF TIME WITHIN WHICH ARGUMENTS AND REBUTTAL ARGUMENTS FOR OR AGAINST MEASURE MAY BE FILED. NOTICE OF CENTRAL COUNTING LOCATION. NOTICE OF WEEKEND OFFICE HOURS. NOTICE OF LAST DAY TO REGISTER. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN by Ryan Ronco, Placer County Clerk-Recorder-Registrar of Voters, in accordance with the provisions of the Election Laws of the State of California, on November 5, 2019 there will be a Special General Election to be held for California State Senate, 1st District.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that consolidated with the Special General Election the following measure shall be put to a vote of the qualified voters in the Squaw Valley Public Service District Community Facilities District:

Measure E – Squaw Valley Public Service District Community Facilities District:

“Shall the measure creating the Olympic Meadow Preserve for public use and benefit on the 30-acre Poulsen Property, preventing private development, creating hiking trails, and preserving natural open space and Squaw Creek’s watershed, with Squaw Valley Public Service District levying an annual special tax of \$284 per residential unit until ended by voters, with other rates for other land uses, annual inflation adjustments, raising approximately \$1,525,000 annually, and authorizing bonds and an appropriations limit of \$17,500,000, be adopted?”

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that direct arguments for or against said measures shall be submitted to the Placer County Elections Office. Said arguments shall not exceed 300 words in length and may be received or withdrawn prior to and including August 19, 2019 at 5:00 PM. The Placer County Registrar of Voters shall cause (if submitted) one argument for and/or one argument against said measure to be printed and shall cause to be enclosed a copy thereof in each County Voter Information Guide. If multiple arguments are submitted either for or against a measure, the Placer County Registrar of Voters shall choose and print one argument in accordance with applicable law or procedure.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that, for individuals interested in submitting arguments for or against said measure, the physical address for the Placer County Elections Office is 2956 Richardson Drive, Auburn. The mailing address for the Placer County Elections Office is PO Box 5278, Auburn, CA 95604.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that when the Placer County Registrar of Voters has selected the direct arguments for and against said measure, the Placer County Registrar of Voters shall send copies of

the argument in favor of said measure to the authors of the argument against and copies of the argument against to the authors of the argument in favor. The authors may prepare and submit rebuttal arguments not to exceed 250 words. The rebuttal arguments must be filed with the Placer County Registrar of Voters not later than 10 days after the final date for filing direct arguments. The final date for rebuttal arguments is August 29, 2019 at 5:00 PM.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that California Elections Code Section 9600 governs the form of said arguments and/or rebuttals. Arguments and/or rebuttals submitted to the Placer County Elections Office must follow this form. Authors of said arguments/rebuttals may call the Elections Office at 530-886-5650 for more information and a copy of this Elections Code Section.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that at the Governing Board Member Election, three (3) candidates will be elected to the governing board of the McKinney Water District for four (4) year terms.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that Declarations of Candidacy for eligible candidates desiring for the above elective offices may be obtained from the Placer County Elections Office at 2956 Richardson Drive, Auburn, CA 95603, Monday through Friday from 8:00 AM to 5:00 PM, excluding holidays. Completed Declarations of Candidacy shall be returned to the Placer County Elections Office by the end of the filing period.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that filing is open Monday, July 15, 2019 and will close Friday, August 9, 2019, after which time no Declaration of Candidacy may be accepted for filing. If an incumbent does not file his or her Declaration of Candidacy on or before August 9, 2019, the period for all non-incumbents to obtain and return Declarations of Candidacy will be extended to August 14, 2019.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that the last day to register to vote for the Special General Election is October 21, 2019.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that vote by mail ballots will begin to mail on October 7, 2019. The last day for the Elections Office to mail a requested vote by mail ballot is October 29, 2019.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that at the Special General Election the polls will be open from the hour of 7:00 AM to the hour of 8:00 PM on the day thereof.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that after the polls are closed on the date of said election, the ballots will be transported to the central counting location at the Placer County Elections Office, 2956 Richardson Drive, Auburn, CA 95603.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that the opening and processing of the vote by mail ballots for said election will take place at the Placer County Elections Office starting October 22, 2019 and continue through Election Night, November 5, 2019.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that the canvass will commence on or before 8:00 AM on November 6, 2019 at the Placer County Elections Office.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that the Elections Office will be open for business the weekend prior to the Special General Election, November 2nd and 3rd, from 9:00 AM to 4:00 PM.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN, in accordance with provisions of the election laws of the State of California, on November 6, 2019 at 10:00 AM, the Placer County Elections Office will randomly select precincts for a manual tally of one percent (1%) of the precincts casting ballots at the November 5, 2019 Special General Election.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that this random selection of precincts is open to the public.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that on November 7, 2019 at 9:00 AM, the Placer County Elections Office will begin a manual tally of one percent (1%) of the precincts casting ballots at the November 5, 2019 Special General Election.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that this manual tally is open to the public and shall continue daily (Saturdays, Sundays, and holidays excluded, unless otherwise decided by the County Registrar of Voters) until completed.
