Candidate filing for the General Election to be held November 6, 2018 begins on July 16, 2018. Every General Election, dozens of people are appointed to local district boards because there are not enough people who file for office. There are several local offices that will not appear on the November ballot if additional individuals do not file.

You have until August 10, 2018 (or August 15th if the incumbent fails to file) to file for local office and make a difference in your community. If you would like to have a say in what happens in your community, filing for office is the perfect opportunity to do so. Give voters a choice in who will be making the decisions that affect them, instead of the board appointing someone for you.

Placer County residents in the Tahoe area will also be able to file at the Tahoe Customs House located at 775 North Lake Blvd in Tahoe City. Candidates can file for office there Tuesday through Thursday, from 11:00 AM - 3:30 PM. Candidates wishing to file in Tahoe City the first day begins July 17, 2018, instead of July 16. For offices that extend candidates can file August 13th – 15th, Monday – Wednesday from 11:00 AM – 3:30 PM.
