It gives them time to think about their voting choices, return their ballot on or before Election Day, and they do not have to plan time to appear at a specific polling place. In Placer County, nearly 75% of voters will request to vote by mail.

Contact our office by phone for a one-time vote-by-mail ballot request OR complete and return the attached form for Permanent Vote-by-Mail status. Your official ballot will be delivered to your mailbox for every future election. You will remain a Vote-By-Mail Voter unless you terminate that status in writing, or you do not vote your PVBM ballot for four consecutive statewide general elections (Elections Code Sec. 3206).
